Skaters in Free Skate 1-6 may compete at their highest Free Skate test passed or one level higher; and may have passed Pre-Preliminary Moves in the Field only. All other skaters may compete at their highest Free Skate test or one level higher. Deadline for tests passed is May 19, 2012.</p>	<p>The registration table will be open throughout the competition. COMPETITION EVENTS

Basic Skills Elements Events

- To be skated on 1/2 ice with no music in 1:00 min or less
- **All elements must be skated in the order listed**
- Each skater will have the option to perform one element at a time in the order listed below (no excessive connecting steps) **OR** will perform each element when directed by a judge or referee

Basic Skills Program Events

- The elements required are the same as the Basic Skills Elements Events and may be found in the table below.
- The skating order of the required elements is optional. The elements are not restricted as to the number of times the element is executed or length of glides, number of revolutions, etc. unless otherwise specified.
- To be skated on full ice and music with vocals is allowed. Time: 1:00 +/- 10 seconds
- The skater may use elements from a previous level. A deduction of .2 will be taken for each element performed from a higher level

Free Skate Compulsory Events

- In program form, using a limited number of connecting steps, skating order of the required elements is optional
- To be skated on 1/2 ice with no music in 1:15 min or less
- **The skater must demonstrate the required elements and may use but is not required to use any additional elements from previous levels**
- A .2 deduction will be taken for each element performed from a higher level
